- Projects are designed in host countries in cooperation with local and international partners



About the project

The project is part of a bilateral cooperation between Israel and India. The implementing parties are MASHAV and the Ministry of Agriculture of India. Close to 30 Centers of Excellence were jointly set up according to the requirements and needs of the Indian Government, providing a sustainable platform for the transfer of Israeli agro-technologies adapted to the local conditions and requirements of the farmers.
